Squirrel Update - in October 2012 the Solway Red Squirrel Group was set up. We are volunteers who aim to promote the preservation of the red squirrel population in their natural habitat within the Solway area and protect them from extinction. The decline of the red squirrel is directly attributable to grey squirrels introduced from America in 1876. The bigger greys out compete the red squirrels for food but more critically a large number carry the highly infectious Squirrel Pox Virus Disease to which they seem immune but is fatal to the reds. Thank you to everyone who has reported sightings and those who are actively helping control grey squirrels - in the Rosley area there are 26 fewer greys but there is still a lot of work to be done. Where greys are controlled reds do come back and thrive. **If you would be willing to help or if you see any squirrels, red or grey please contact us on 01228 711520 or solwayredsquirrels@hotmail.co.uk**
