Better Broadband - Mrs A. West gave an update on the progress of the bid and explained that a lot of hard work was going on behind the scenes.

Wind Energy - with reference to the application for two large turbines at Ling Lane representatives from Sebergham & Welton Parish Council outlined their concerns on all the issues involved and asked for Westward Council's support in opposing the application. A scoping application has been made for a turbine at Hilltop, Brocklebank. The action group FORCE and members of the public attended and expressed their concerns at the worrying increase in the amount of applications for large single turbines and the cumulative effect these will have on the landscape.
