When was the last time you saw 'your' red squirrels?

The decline of red squirrels is directly attributable to grey squirrels, the bigger grey out competes red squirrels for food and would displace them over time but, more critically, a large number carry the highly infectious Squirrelpox Virus to which they are immune but which is fatal to red squirrels. It is vitally important that grey squirrel numbers are controlled as at present this the only way to protect the reds. We know this system works because of the many reports of reds re-colonising woods that had been lost to greys, once the way has been cleared for them. **PLEASE report any sightings of grey squirrels** to me, details above - also any sightings of sickly reds.

The future of 'your' red squirrels may depend on it.
