Broadband

The government has announced that there will be four pilot schemes around the country to investigate ways to ensure that rural areas have access to high-speed broadband. Rory Stewart MP successfully lobbied to get Cumbria included in this pilot. An interactive website www.broadbandcumbria.com has been set up to act as a focus for people in the county to discuss plans and ideas for better broadband provision. If you are interested in faster broadband, please register on this site; you will find many interesting contributions from members throughout Cumbria. When you are on the site please join the Rosley and Westward Community Group as this is where information will be posted about any developments within our area. It is very important that, as a community, we show that we really want to be part of the Better Broadband Challenge and we hope to organise a public meeting as soon as we have sufficient information on the practical possibilities.

Windfarm Concern

The most recent planning application, for an anemometer mast at Reathwite Farm, Brocklebank was refused by the Allerdale Development Panel on 14th Dec. It is not yet known whether the applicant will appeal. In the meantime it is assumed that the wind energy companies will be preparing their environmental impact assessments in relation to possible future applications for large turbines at Reathwaite Farm and Carwath Farm, Rosley. Rory Stewart MP has said he would give his support in opposing any such proposals, and has offered to attend a public meeting arranged on a date convenient to him. When a date is known details will be publicised on the Rosley website and hopefully in the Cumberland News
