Windfarm Concern

The 60m anemometer mast was erected in January. It gives an idea of how tall the turbines being considered would be. At 60m high, the mast is the same height as the towers of the turbines described in the scoping application but, in addition, the rotating blades would add up to 40 m, giving a maximum total height of 100m.
